

## Job Description INTERN-PRIVATE MARKETS

20-25 hours a week The private markets intern will help the management team to grow the business and create new opportunities and attract potential clients.

The ideal candidate will always represent HB&P, its ethos and professional mission.

Interns may be assigned to one particular team:

- **Impact Investments**: investments in sectors such as energy efficiency, sustainable land use and agriculture which generate measurable environmental and/or social impacts
- **Infrastructure Debt**: direct debt investments in infrastructure projects and corporates in EMEA & Latin America, wide ranging from "core" infrastructure such as roads and wind farms, to "core+" and "profit" infrastructure such as smart meters, fiber and new energy technologies
- **Infrastructure**: direct and indirect equity investments in infrastructure in EMEA and Latam, covering infrastructure assets which provide crucial services to the public and are supported by regulated or contracted revenues or a strong market position
- **Renewables**: direct equity investments in renewable power generation assets, such as wind farms and solar parks
- **Investment Business Management**: supporting the development of the RAPM investment platform through the coordination, analysis and research of new projects, and the preparation of strategic documents and presentations for senior management.

This will be a 6 month placement, subject to candidates' availability. The start dates will be either January 2025 or September 2025.

## **Key Responsibilities**

- Participate in origination, marketing, structuring and execution of private markets transactions
- Perform due diligence and credit analysis, create or test financial models and build the investment thesis for opportunities to be presented to the investment committee
- Develop new investment product ideas and work cross-functionally for the build-out of the product
- Assist the team in fundraising for new investment strategies and in strategic development via preparation of marketing materials and investor due diligence documents
